- Opportunity to travel and volunteer at special events.

### To complete your application, you must submit both Form A & Form B.



### **NWT Youth Ambassador – Application Form:**

- Summary of personal information
- Responses to all applicant questions



### NWT Youth Ambassador - Reference Forms:

- Two references are required. A reference person can be a teacher, a coach, a person of authority, or other adult outside of your family who knows you well.
- Reference letter must be progam specific, and no older than 6 months

## **Eligibility – NWT Youth Ambassadors must:**

- be between 16 and 22 years of age as of January 1, 2023;
- be a resident of the Northwest Territories:
- hold valid NWT Health Care;
- be able to attend the mandatory orientation session from November 3-7, 2022

- Community involvement
- Commitment to a healthy lifestyle
- Completed Form A
- Two completed Letter of Reference Forms (Form B)
- A current Police Record Check including Vulnerable Sector Check
