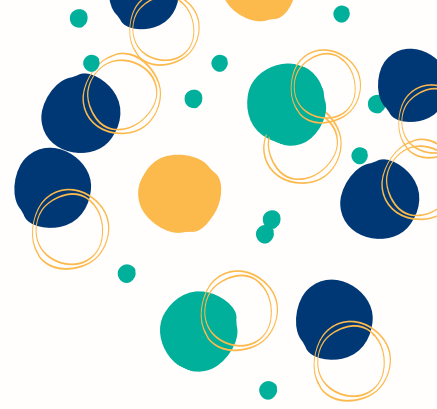

### Important details regarding charters to/from Whitehorse

- **Checked Bag Weight Allowance:** Air North will be enforcing a **strict 40 lbs checked bag weight** allowance per passenger. Bags will be weighed upon check-in at YZF and may be removed if overweight.
- **Check-In Time:** Please check-in 3 hours prior to departure, arrive no later than 10:30 AM at the Yellowknife Airport. Find Neilson and Akiko. Before checking in at the ticket counter, find your Table Tennis coach to receive host bag tags. Check-in will not be permitted without. Bag tag colour is black. Table Tennis will check-in as a team once all participants receive their bag tag.

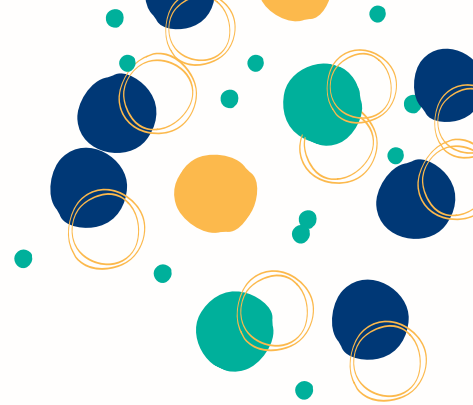
If you haven't installed **WHATSAPP** yet, please do as this will be our main way of communicating with athletes and parents during the games.

### Athletes' Accommodations & Meals
