Board Report

Members celebrated another successful year of growth for Table Tennis across the Northwest Territories. Highlights included increased participation, expanded club development, Team NT representation at the Canadian Championships, Western Canadian Championships, and Arctic Winter Games, as well as continued investment in coach development, Safe Sport, and national leadership.

Finance

The membership approved the 2025, 2026 financial statements. Table Tennis North reported a deficit of just over \$12,000, primarily due to the purchase of new table Tennis Tables to support long term programming and growth across the territory. Several tables remain available for sale, which is expected to recover a portion of these costs.

Governance

The membership approved a motion authorizing the Board of Directors to determine the initial staggered terms required to implement the organization's new bylaws.
